

Archery Range Rules:

- Crossbows, broadheads, handguns, rifles, and shotguns are prohibited.
- Alcoholic Beverages are prohibited.
- Devices that lock a bow at a full or partial draw may not be used on the range.
- No sky pulling. Sky pulling is holding the bow high and pulling back on the arrow while lowering the bow to a shooting position. If the arrow is accidentally released during a sky pull, the arrow could land downrange and endanger other people.
- Pets are prohibited.
- Hunting is prohibited on the range.
- Maximum of six arrows per shooter per round
- Shoot only at designated targets.
- Wait for all shooters to finish before advancing from the firing line.
- Do not commence firing if you observe a bow in front of ANY target on the range.
- If other shooters are waiting to shoot in your lane, please be courteous and rotate to the back of the line after your round.
- Keep the area clean and pick up after yourself.
